Scholarship - students who receive a StFX scholarship use 50\% as part of the 1st term payment
NS Bursary - Student who receive the NS Bursary use $50 \%$ (\$641.50) as part of 1st term payment

## Late Payment Fee:

First Term - \$50 - if payment delayed beyond September 15
Second Term - \$50 - if payment delayed beyond January 15
Interest charged at the rate of $1 \%$ per month (12\% per annum) on overdue balances on the last day of each month.
