The **Department of Management** in the **Gerald Schwartz School of Business** invites applications for a part-time instructor to teach Social Entrepreneurship (BSAD 352, fall semester only, 3 credits). The term of the appointment is from September 1 to December 31, 2024.

The Gerald Schwartz School of Business houses three departments and offers a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree with several degree streams, a thesis-based honours program, a co-op option, and multiple international exchange opportunities. The Department of Management offers Majors and Honours degrees in Management and Leadership, Entrepreneurship, and International Business. The focus of the course, Social Entrepreneurship, is how entrepreneurship is combined with the tools of business to create effective responses to social needs, and innovative solutions to social problems.
