

Report to Faculty Regarding the First Regular University Senate Meeting October 6, 2021

Motions Carried:

1. Motions from the VP Academic:

- i. Move that the CAR Report for Math and Statistics be approved by Senate. **Passed**
- ii. Move that the annual March 1 deadline to apply for Entrance Scholarships
 [scholarships based on final Grade 12 averages] be eliminated. Eligibility for
 guaranteed entrance scholarships will be determined upon receipt of a student's
 confirmation of acceptance to the University and receipt of their official Grade 12
 final transcript. [The March 1st deadline for the University's Major Scholarships, and
 all other eligibility requirements, will remain. Regulations regarding subsequent
 retention of Entrance Scholarships will also be unchanged]. Passed

2. Motions from the Associate Vice-President Research and Graduate Studies:

- i. Move that CSCI 5XX: Machine Learning Design be approved. Passed
- ii. Move that CSCI 5XX: Mobile Robotics be approved. Passed

3. Motions from the Deans:

i. Dean of Arts:

- Move that HIST 2xx (three credits) History for the People?: An Introduction to Public History be approved. Passed
- 2. Move that the proposal from the Interdisciplinary **AQUA program** to eliminate the 65% progression rule be approved. **Passed**
- 3. Move that the proposal from the Interdisciplinary **AQUA Program** for an open enrollment in AQUA 100 and AQUA 200 level courses for all StFX student be approved. **Passed**

ii. Dean of Science:

- 1. Move that Biology 4XX (Animal Minds) be approved. Passed
 - Some discussion was had regarding the lack of indigenous content, and some members voted against the motion. Approval was not unanimous.
- Move that Physics 252 (Digital Signal Processing for Scientists and Engineers) be approved. Passed
