



Shinerama is Canada's largest post-secondary fundraiser in support of Cystic Fibrosis Canada. Over 20,000 student volunteers from 36 Canadian universities and colleges come together every year to make a difference in the lives of those battling cystic fibrosis (CF).

Shinerama began in 1964 as a simple shoe-shining fundraiser to encourage first-year students to meet new people and give back to their local community during orientation week. It has since grown to include a wide variety of community and campus-based events under the Shinerama banner. Student volunteers remain as dedicated as ever and are doing whatever it takes to raise crucial funds to fight cystic fibrosis. To date. Shinerama has raised approximately \$29 million for Cystic Fibrosis Canada.

StFX is one of the leading universities in Shinerama fundraising. To date, StFX has raised over \$680,000 for CF! Each year, StFX hosts a 'Shine Day' in which Orientation Crew leaders, ResLife leaders, and incoming students travel to local businesses to fundraise for the day. It takes place throughout the town of Antigonish and oncampus.

On September 10th 2022, the Shinerama committee will lead StFX in an incredible day of fundraising fun! Keep your eyes peeled for Shinerama swag that will be sold during orientation. All proceeds go towards CF. We hope to see you all there!
